### Item Minute

#### 1 Accounts

The accounts for the year 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2011 had been discussed and approved in draft by the Council (minute 51.1) and circulated to the membership with the October 2011 issue of *Skydive the Mag*.

Weed Stoodley proposed, and Paul Applegate seconded, a motion that the accounts should be formally approved and adopted. This carried unanimously.

#### 2 Auditors

John Page then proposed, and Richard Head seconded, a motion that Progress Accountants LLP be re-appointed as auditors and that the Council be authorised to fix their remuneration for the next financial year.

Carried unanimously

3 <u>Student Provisional Membership and Temporary Membership Subscriptions 2012/13</u>
Debbie Carter (Treasurer) reported that the BPA had negotiated with the insurers for the insurance premium for the next membership year to be 5% lower. She recommended that BPA

element of the subscription should be subject to the usual increase of 3%, even though inflation was now running at around 5%. She tabled a document setting out the new subscription rates that resulted from these percentage variations.

The insurance element was subject to the insurers' usual caveat of there being no significant additional insurance claims between now and the start of the new membership year on 1 April 2012.

The overall effect was a year-on-year *reduction* of 55p in the Student Provisional Membership subscription, and a *reduction* of 50p in the Temporary Membership subscription, as set out in the table below. Ian Marshall proposed, and Paul Moore seconded, a motion to agree these subscription rates.
